

THE PREAMBLE <

The preamble is the introduction to the United States Constitution. It explains what the Constitution is supposed to do and what the goals of the government should be.

We the People of the United States, in Order to form a more perfect Union, establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for the United States of America.

Read the preamble out loud and highlight the 6 different purposes of the Constitution. Circle all the words that are difficult to understand.

Now lets make it a little easier to understand by defining these words:

JUSTICE → FAIRNESS

DOMESTIC → AT HOME OR INSIDE THE COUNTRY

TRANQUILITY → PEACE

WELFARE → WELL-BEING

LIBERTY → FREEDOM

POSTERITY → CHILDREN

ENACT

ORDAIN
